## **Greektown Casino-Hotel Announces Michigan Gaming Control Board Confirmation of New Executives**

**Randall A. Fine and Amanda Totaro confirmed as CEO and VP of Marketing**

Detroit, Mich. – April 20, 2009 – Greektown Casino-Hotel announced today the approval of two new executives by the Michigan Gaming Control Board (MGCB). While both have been serving in these positions pending regulatory approval by the MGCB, Randall A. Fine has now been confirmed as Chief Executive Officer and Amanda Totaro has been confirmed as Vice President of Marketing. Fine and Totaro also serve as Managing Director and Senior Vice President, respectively, at The Fine Point Group, the Las Vegas-based consulting firm retained by Greektown to provide comprehensive operations and marketing management.

Since Fine Point Group took over the management of the Greektown Casino-Hotel in January 2009, the property has increased its market share from 23.5 percent in February to 25 percent in March, according to MGCB figures. From January, where the property had 22.8 percent market share, the net increase was 2.2 percent, an increase of almost 10 percent.
